⁷ Program unable to fill vacancies due to lack of single women meeting the chronic homeless criteria. HUD accepted a change in eligibility criteria for the program in April. The chronic homeless criteria was replaced with Rebuilding Lives criteria. USHS is working on filling the vacant units.
