- ODE Students with Disabilities Compendium of Resources
- Be Prepared for Telehealth
  - On June 19, 2020, Governor DeWine signed <u>House Bill 164</u> of the 133<sup>rd</sup> General Assembly. Section 5 of this new law which permits all school providers to use telehealth for the entirety of the 2020-2021 school year.
- Ensuring student and family privacy
  - To help expand the use of telehealth during the national emergency, the Office of Civil Rights (OCR) will temporarily allow the use of applications that are not fully HIPAA compliant such as Apple FaceTime, Facebook Messenger video chat, Google Hangouts and Skype. See HIPAA Telehealth.


